- Promotes safety through conducting and participating in safety meetings, providing safe work conditions, correcting unsafe actions, providing discipline as appropriate, investigation of personal injuries, train accidents, and other incidents.
- Maintains a working knowledge of appropriate labor agreements, environmental (40 CFR), AREMA, OSHA, FRA, and other rules & regulations.
