- Works independently designing and fabricating various brackets, structural supports, etc. as needed.

**Job Requirements:**

- Valid driver's license is required.
- High School Diploma or equivalent (GED) is required.
- A minimum of 3 years work experience in the mechanical maintenance field with an emphasis in diesel powered engines, troubleshooting, repairs, overhauls and fuel/lubricating systems is required.
- 4 years of work experience with welding/burning and metal fabrication is preferred.
- The ability to use precision measuring tools is preferred.
- Locomotive experience - running repair, truck overhaul, EMD engine experience or formal railroad locomotive maintenance training is preferred.
- Technical training related to machinist/mechanic work, alignment of rotating equipment, compressed air brake maintenance, and heavy equipment maintenance is preferred.
- Locomotive electrical training is a plus.
- Ability to work overtime, weekends, holidays, and on-call is required.
- A minimum of one year outdoor and industrial work experience is required.
- Ability to work outdoors in inclement weather conditions is required.
- Performing manual labor and lifting in excess of 50 pounds is required.
